1. Write a word problem whose solution involves subtraction. Identify the minuend, subtrahend, and difference. Solve the problem using at least two different models of subtraction, including missing addend.
2. What is division? Give several answers, and examples showing aspects of division captured by one answer but neglected by another. You may find it helpful to think about both division of integers and division of fractions.
3. Write a word problem whose solution involves division. Then solve the problem using division. Solve it again, using multiplication, but not division. Solve it again, using a number line model for division.
